Whole Church Family Night (WCFN) is an opportunity for the Holy Trinity parish family to be more whole. You can meet people who attend a different weekend service, spend time with friends, and connect with God in the middle of the week. There will be a gentle 30-minute prayer service to help with the stress of life, a delicious meal, and opportunities to go deeper in your faith. And WCFN is for all ages... the "Whole Church Family" at Holy Trinity!

PRAYER SERVICE (5:30-6:00pm): Come to the Historic Chapel for 30 minutes of worship with gentle music. The service (based on "An Order for the Evening" from the BCP) will be led by one of the priests who will remain at the altar rail afterward for anyone desiring personal prayer.

TRINITY RINGERS BELL CHOIR REHEARSAL (5:00-6:00pm): Holy Trinity's hand bell choir enriches the worship at the 9:00am service. The rehearsal will be in the Lou West Music Room in Pearson Hall.

BUFFET DINNER (5:45-6:45pm): Enjoy a delicious meal prepared by Chef Daniel Farr and fellowship with your church family. Reservations can be made now (for the first night) by signing up in the Narthex, RSVPing on Facebook, or calling the church office (321-723-5272). After the first night please sign up for dinner each Wednesday for the next Wednesday or RSVP as directed above. Free-will donations will be welcome.

FROLIC NURSERY CARE (6:15-7:45pm): LITTLE STEPS FOR BIG FAITH! A new program for our youngest children at Holy Trinity will take place during WCFN on Wednesdays during the school year. Much more than just childcare, this program is for those children 3 years and younger and takes place in the church nursery. They will explore basic stories of the Bible in a fun, playful environment!

FAMILY CHOIR REHEARSAL (6:30-7:45pm): The choir provides musical leadership in the 9:00am service. The rehearsal will be in the Lou West Music Room in Pearson Hall. Come and sing to the glory of God!

TREASURE KID CLUB (6:30-7:45pm): Treasure Kids Club (TKC) is our midweek program for children in VPK – 6th grade. This year we will study *Walking with the Wise, Connecting Proverbs with God's Story*. About Pastor Allen Griffin

Allen Griffin is one of the most influential and effective speakers today. His dynamic presentation is both humorous and insightful. Allen is a published author, mentor and life coach that has a great desire for the word of God to infiltrate the lives of everyone, everywhere.



Originally from Michigan, Allen received his BA and Masters degrees from Southeastern University in Lakeland, Florida. Allen served for six years as a short-term missionary to Hong Kong and lead teams from 2005 to 2011. He is married to Hashmareen and they are currently Staff Evangelists at Calvary Christian Center in Ormond Beach, Florida.

Excellerate was founded and established by Allen and his wife for the spiritual, social and educational development of orphan teens that have been all but forgotten by the government and many social groups. This pilot program is reaching out to the hundreds of boys and girls who have no hope of family or future as they "Age Out" of the foster care system.

Allen and Hashmareen identified the great need to bring this partnership to the state agencies that have carried the burden of care for these students. Allen also felt that a gift was needed. A gift that would inspire and bring a greater sense of normalcy to the student... a car. In September of 2012, *Excellerate* launched its first class and has been doing so biannually ever since. *Excellerate* has influenced students to attend college/universities, aided in job placement, motivated completion of High School diplomas/equivalence, and provided support to the major milestones of our students' lives.

HEALTH MINISTRY NEWS!

Are you addicted to your smartphone? As great as smart phones are you can be too attached to the gadgets. How to tell if it has become your BFF. According to experts at the Cleveland Clinic's center for Behavioral Health, cell phone overuse can be like any other addiction. Two warning signs: your smartphone is interfering with your life, and you get withdrawal symptoms when you try cutting back. Try to set aside a few hours of no-phone time each day by doing reading, being with family or friends and enjoying dining time with the phone turned off or left in another room. Above all, don't let your phone interfere with getting enough restful sleep. Stop using it at least an hour before you go to sleep – looking at gadget screens can interfere with body's natural process of winding down. Be sure not to charge it in your bedroom, if you charge it overnight, so that it can't wake you if you get a message.
