RECTOR SEARCH UPDATE

Do you believe that God has already chosen the next Rector for Holy Trinity? Your Search Committee does. While there is a lot of work to do to in preparation to receive names and profiles of candidates, our most important task is that of discerning God's will. Your continued prayers are a blessing.

Sub-committees are working on the following:

A parish survey that is brief yet focused on gathering information that clarifies what is in the hearts and minds of all parishioners including children and youth. To gather yet more information, the Search Committee will hold a series of forums.

A parish profile that reflects the character of Holy Trinity Episcopal Church. This is what clergy who are seeking a new position will view. It can take many forms and the committee working on this project is considering numerous creative ways to show the vibrancy of our parish. The profile will also be incorporated into the Holy Trinity website.

An OTM (Office of Transitional Ministry) Community Portfolio. The information gathered in the portfolio is input into a national database.

In addition to the prayers and support of the Holy Trinity parish family, the Search Committee has as a resource The Rev. Canon Scott T. Holcombe, Canon to the Ordinary for Congregational Development for the Diocese of Central Florida. We have met with him in-person and he will be accessible to the committee as needed.

Almighty God, giver of every good gift: look graciously on each of us in your beloved Church, and so guide the hearts and minds of those who shall choose a Rector for this parish, that we may receive a faithful pastor who will care for your people and equip us for our ministries; through Jesus Christ our Lord.
