JESUS says, "I AM"

Focus on What Jesus says about Himself in Lent

Wednesday evenings at 7:00pm in the church

In Lent we use a prayer that says, *"Jesus Christ was tempted in every way as we are, yet did not sin. And so it is by his grace (his gift) that we are able to triumph over every evil, and to live no longer for ourselves alone, but for him who died for us and rose again."* Please consider making it your highest spiritual priority this Lent to focus on Jesus and his grace! Focusing on Jesus helps us overcome our selfishness and experience new creation and resurrection in this life, as we look forward to eternity.

Specifically, this Lent, we invite you to focus on what Jesus says about himself in the "I Am" statements in the Gospel of John. On the five Wednesdays after Ash Wednesday, Holy Trinity will worship with Evening Prayer and a special teaching as follows:

- March 9:** Jesus says I AM the Bread of Life (John chapter 6); Speaker – Fr. Dave Newhart. We all have a deep hunger for God, and Jesus is the one who nourishes us.
- March 16:** Jesus says I AM the Light of the World (John chapter 8); Speaker – Fr. Bob Bruckart. The Light of Jesus shines in our darkness of fear and anger and unbelief, and the darkness cannot overcome his Light.
- March 23:** Jesus says I AM the Door of the sheep and the Good Shepherd (John chapter 10); Speaker – Deacon Stacey Westphal. We find safety and a fulfilled life in Jesus our Good Shepherd. He knows you by name and is always ready to pick you up to get you back on the path to abundant and eternal life.
- March 30:** Jesus says I AM the True Vine (John chapter 15); Speaker – Deacon Christine Croskey. Jesus is the Vine and we are the branches. We grow by drawing strength from Christ.
- April 6:** Jesus says I AM the Resurrection and the Life, and I AM the Way, the Truth and the Life (John chapter 11 and chapter 14) Speaker – Fr. Bill Lewis. Jesus is "Resurrection in Person." Jesus himself is the Truth and Life through which we find the Way home to God.

Implicit in all the I AM statements is that Jesus is God. We say in the Nicene Creed, "We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ... true God from true God." Jesus said, "I AM." When asked his name, God had said to Moses in Exodus 3:13-14, "I AM Who I AM."

This Lent, experience a deeper relationship with God in Christ Jesus!

REFLECTION ON LENT

They say that time flies when you are having fun. For me it is hard to believe that I have been back at Holy Trinity for nine months. Over the past months I have had the joy of experiencing Advent, Christmas, Epiphany and now Lent. Yes Lent! Lent is one of my favorite seasons in the church calendar. I personally find great joy in the Lenten season. Some may ask why? I find Lent to be a time to slow down, to reflect on my relationship with God and really experience God's power in my life. It is like hitting the reset button.

I look at Lent from two perspectives. The first is giving something up for Lent and the second way is doing something that makes a positive change in my life. Both approaches to the 40 days requires me to rely on God and draws me into a deeper relation and dependance on God's strength. Lots of people give something up. When I give up something towards the end of Lent, I find I rely more on God for the strength not to proverbially grab that Klondike Bar or whatever I gave up. The other thing in Lent is to do something that makes a positive change in my life. It does not have to be something major. It might be getting up a little earlier in the morning, extending the distance I walk, cutting down on my coffee consumption, eating broccoli, making sure I take a Sabbath day. Lenten disciplines do not have to be something major or epic. In fact, the simpler sometimes is the hardest.

As you enter Lent my prayer is for you to have a blessed and joyous Lent as you experience God's presence as He strengthens you.
