## A Few Words from Fr. Dave

Jeremiah 29:11-12 For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the LORD, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope. Then when you call upon me and come and pray to me, I will hear you. (NRS).

Little did I or Tillie know that when I first came back to Holy Trinity in June 2021 that I would become the Priest-in-Charge a little more than a year later. It has just been a little over six weeks since that transition occurred. For me I am truly blessed to have all the support I have from you, the staff, the ministries, the clergy, and the Vestry as I adjust to the new position and responsibilities.

As we all move further into the transition phase, it continues to be bathed in much prayer. Prayers for a smooth transition, stability, and continuity.

This is evident in what is currently happening. In the last newsletter the column I wrote was entitled New and Renewed. It focused on the ministries that were coming up in the fall and beyond. All of which have either started and will be started by the first week of October; Wednesday Healing service, Bible study, Alpha leaders training, Foyer groups, Saturday Kenyan Eucharistic service, and Prayer teams at the 9:00 service.



## From Parish Nurse, Rev. Stacey Westphal, Deacon

**Health Ministry Team:** We are meeting once again, and planning to bring back monthly Blood Pressure Clinics to all four worship services on Saturday evenings and Sundays. We are hoping to start back up in October. Sunday forums are back on the agenda. We are planning to hold monthly health forums on Sundays after the 9:00am service shortly after coffee hour in the parish hall.

**October's Sunday Forum: Soul Injury:** Our first forum this year will be on October 16 following the the 9:00am service in the Parish Hall. Our Speaker will be Deacon Christine who will speak on Soul Injury. Soul Injuries are caused by unmourned loss/hurt, unforgiven guilt/shame, and a fear of helplessness and loss of control. These barriers gradually disconnect you from the energy of your deepest self, robbing you of the essence of your being.

**Flu Season is Here:** Flu is a contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses that infect the nose, throat, and sometimes the lungs. It can cause mild to severe illness, and at times can lead to death. <u>The best way to prevent flu is by getting a flu vaccine each year</u>.

Flu season 2019-2020 Statistics to date:

- 35,000,000 people had symptomatic illnesses
- 16,000,000 people visited a medical facility for their symptoms
- 380,000 were admitted to the hospital
- 20,000 people died from the flu

**Flu Symptoms:** Influenza (flu) can cause mild to severe illness, and at times can lead to death. Flu symptoms usually come on suddenly. People who have flu often feel some or all of these symptoms: fever or feeling feverish/ chills, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle or body aches, headaches, fatigue (tiredness), some people may have vomiting and diarrhea, though this is more common in children than adults.

People at higher risk of serious flu complications include <u>young children</u>, <u>pregnant women</u>, people with certain chronic health conditions like <u>asthma</u>, <u>diabetes</u> or <u>heart</u> and lung disease, and <u>people 65 years and older</u>.
