Holy Trinity's 2020 Stewardship Campaign

This year's stewardship campaign theme is based upon a hymn from our hymnal – **Be Thou My Vision**. We ask that God guide our approach to stewardship as we begin to roll out this fall's stewardship campaign and as members start to consider

our pledges for calendar year 2020. While those of us who now need eye glasses for various purposes may wistfully consider 2020 as 'perfect' vision, we know that God's vision for our lives is the only truly perfect vision.

We hope that you will prayerfully look to God's vision for our lives and to consider increasing your pledge for 2020. Your pledge helps the vestry to plan for the coming year and enables Holy Trinity to continue to spread the Gospel.

We invite you to bring your **Be Thou My Vision 2020** pledge card with you to church the weekend of October 26/27 to present your pledge at the altar during worship.

2020 VISION IN OUR STEWARDSHIP OF TIME, TALENT AND TREASURE

As we have been thinking about the theme for our fall Stewardship campaign, Be Thou My Vision – 20/20 Vision, we have found ourselves looking ahead to 2020 with great enthusiasm. We realized that come July 2020, we will enter our 15^{th} year at Holy Trinity.

Looking back at the many accomplishments and adventures of these years, we realize that this church has really been "Building for God." One of the first projects we all tackled was moving the nursery to its current location to better serve families with young children. Pearson Hall was built to better serve our Choir and Sunday School. The Memorial Wall was built to better serve those who mourn the passing of loved ones to eternal life. Through a complicated process, the Trinity Towers apartments were extensively re-capitalized and re-modeled. Houses on Elizabeth Street have been acquired and remodeled for staff housing and transitional housing for homeless families. The church purchased the old Brevard Rentals building and "remodeled" (almost re-built) it to give us a wonderful new space for our Thrift Shop ministry. The parish hall kitchen was completely remodeled, making possible the parish dinners that are now a wonderful blessing. And of course, our beloved Historic Chapel is nearing completion in its long journey to restoration and revitalization!

For all this building and "rebuilding" we give great thanks to God!!! We also thank the many, many parishioners who gave sacrificially of their time, talent and treasure to make all this building possible. As Fr. Boyer said many years ago, it is always a privilege to "build for God." There will be some celebrations coming up, particularly for the Thrift Shop and the Historic Chapel as we rejoice together in what has been accomplished for God and with God's help.

We are thankful, but we are also looking forward to 2020 as a year to shift the focus to building up the Body of Christ. In 2020 we hope to have an intentional pause in construction so that we can discern God's redemptive presence in our midst and discover anew God's vision for Holy Trinity Episcopal Church.

We will have more to say about that in the coming months, but the beginning place is thankfulness – thankfulness for God, for God's creation and redemption, for God's ongoing mercies, and for evidence of God's grace.

2020 will be a great year where we re-discover a great vision in Christ together. As a parish we have the buildings. We have the personnel. We have the tools to be a very creative church to the glory of God. Please join us in thankfulness and give generously, and then in 2020 vision with us so that together we see clearly what we can accomplish together in Christ.
