An Old-Fashioned FLOWERING of the Cross on Easter

Have you ever seen the mob of families in the Memorial Garden huddled around an old, rustic, wire covered cross on Easter morning? Children grab a few daisies left on the Chapel porch to stick into the wire on the cross, slowly transforming the unsightly cross into a beautiful, flower covered reminder of the Resurrection of Christ. Among the families with young children and teenagers, this is a favorite spot for an Easter photo. This Easter we invite the entire Holy Trinity

family to participate in this tradition. We will not process to the cross after the 9 am service as we have in the past, instead we will 'flower the cross' in a more 'old fashioned' way, as you arrive for worship or when you are departing. We encourage you to bring flowers from your yard or flowers that you have purchased to add a variety of flowers. The cross will be in the Memorial Garden from early Easter morning, all day long. We will still offer daisy stems that you can find on the Chapel porch for your use if you are not able to bring flowers. Stop by, add a flower or two as you help transform a symbol of death into a symbol of new, beautiful life.


