September is a busy month!

September 23 - FLU SHOTS: The Visiting Nurses Association will be offering flu shots at Holy Trinity on Saturday from 4:30 to 6:30pm, and then again Sunday, October 22 before and after services. All health insurance will be accepted by the VNA, just bring your cards. If you are not covered and don't have \$35 to cover the cost, there is a voucher program available. There will be sign-up sheets in the Narthex beginning September 1. They will not be vaccinating children under ten years of age.


